## Message from Vicar Rev. Jyothish Sam



Dearly beloved in Christ.

Greetings in the name of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ.

I take this opportunity to give thanks and glory to our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ for the abundant mercy and blessings in the last financial year.

As we all experience the blessings of risen Christ, let us witness our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, Acts 1:8 says "you will be witnesses for me in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth". Every year we celebrate Easter, but we do not live as if the celebration were a reality. The real proof of the resurrection today is not the empty tomb or the post-resurrection appearances, but the living testimony of Christ's followers. Easter disproves the myth that there is nothing beyond the grave. Shakespeare said that death is an unknown territory which no traveller did return, and that is Jesus Christ. Also resurrection of Jesus affirms that the final victory is God's, and that God has the last word.

At the same time the Ascension draws our attention to the following aspects;

1. The universality of Christ. He is no longer confined to Palestine, nor conditioned by time and space, and the limitations of human finitude. Thus there is an integration of all people and all things in Christ {Eph. 1;9-10}.
2. Ascension emphasizes the eternal presence and permanent immanence of Christ. We may think that ascension is the disappearance of Christ from earthly scene. Mat 28;20 says "I am with you always". Soren Kierkegaard the Danish theologian says; "Christ is our eternal contemporary". Our Christ is with us everywhere and at all times.
3. Ascension motivates us for a new life style. We don't have to escape from the world to practice a Christian life style. We can live a new life here and now. "Because you have been raised with Christ, set your mind on things above" {Col. 3;1}. "Be you transformed by the renewal of your mind" {Rom 12;2} May the blessings of our Saviour with us in each and every moments of our lives.

As we are entering new financial year 2018-2019, I praise the Almighty Lord for his mercy and guidance that he showered upon us throughout the year.
